BoG-XXXI (2022)-04: Appointment of Officers in NIT Meghalaya.

Online applications for the post of Assistant Registrar (1-SC, on Lien vacancy) and Student Activity & Sports Officer (SASO) (1-OBC) were called for vide advertisement No. NITMGH/ES/REC/N-F/Vol.V/2021/850 dated 07.10.2021 which was released through the print media and the Institute's website. Candidates were asked to fill-in the online application forms by 18.01.2021 and the hard copies were to reach the Institute on or before 15.11.2021.

The Board was apprised that there were 120 applications received, 105 screened in for written test, 15 candidates appeared for written test and 05 candidates shortlisted for personal interview and the interview was held on 07.03.2022 for the post of Assist Registrar (1-SC, on Lien vacancy). Similarly, there were 29 number of applications received, 23 screened in for written test, 04 candidates appeared for written test and 03 candidates shortlisted for personal interview and the interview was held on 07.03.2022 for the post of Student Activity & Sports Officer (SASO) (1-OBC).

The recommendations of the both the Selection Committees, kept in the sealed cover, were opened and placed before the Board members during the meeting on 18.05.2022.

The Hon'ble Board members discussed the matter at length and resolved to approve the recommendations of the Selection Committees as mentioned below:

<u>BoG-XXXI(2022)-R4</u>: The Board RESOLVED to APPROVE the recommendations of the Selection Committees as mentioned above and for issuing offer of appointment letter to the selected candidate for the post of Assistant Registrar (1-SC, on Lien vacancy).

<u>BoG-XXXI(2022)-05</u>: Proposal for age relaxation of non-teaching employees of NIT Meghalaya as per the provisions of Para A(i) & 5 "One-time measures/ relaxation" of the Ministry's letter No.F.35-5/2018-TS.III dated 20.02.2019 in respect of "Recommendations of Oversight Committee for removal of anomalies of non-teaching staff and revised Recruitment Rules (RRs) for Non-Teaching in the NITs."

It was informed to the Board member that the Institute has adopted the new Recruitment Rules (2019) of Non-Teaching Staff circulated by the MoE vide letter dated 20.02.2019 and 04.04.2019 vide Resolution No. BoG-XXII (2019)-R5 dated 01.04.2019 and No. BoG-XXIII (2019)-R6 dated 07.06.2019 respectively.

As per MoE letter dated 20.02.2019 under Para A(i) "One-time measures/ relaxation", it has been mentioned that "Those employees, who are working on ad-hoc / temporary / contractual / outsource basis, in RECs / NITs, who have rendered a reasonable portion in service of the Institute before 20.02.2019 may be given one-time age relaxation to participate in the first regular recruitment process for the post for which they fulfill all other conditions mentioned in the Recruitment Rules proposed by the Oversight Committee. The quantum of age relaxation may be decided by the Board of Governors of the respective NIT".

In this regard, the copies of various advertisements for non-teaching posts released/published by other NITs showing the quantum of age relaxation were placed before the Board.

The Board deliberated in details and approved the proposal for one-time measure/relaxation in upper age limit for those non teaching employees who are working on ad-hoc / temporary / contractual / outsource basis in NIT Meghalaya and have rendered a reasonable portion in service of the Institute before 20.02.2019. This one time age relaxation shall be for a maximum of 10 years over and above the upper age limit as prescribed in RRs in order to enable them to participate in the first regular recruitment process for the post for which they fulfill all other conditions mentioned in the Recruitment Rules proposed by the Oversight Committee.

<u>BoG-XXX (2022)-R5</u>: The Board CONSIDERED and APPROVED the Proposal for "One-time measures/ relaxation" of non-teaching employees of NIT Meghalaya working on ad-hoc / temporary / contractual / outsource basis in NIT Meghalaya and have rendered a reasonable

portion in service of the Institute before 20.02.2019 as per the provisions of Para A(i) & 5 of the Ministry's letter No.F.35-5/2018-TS.III dated 20.02.2019 in respect of "Recommendations of Oversight Committee for removal of anomalies of non-teaching staff and revised Recruitment Rules (RRs) for Non-Teaching. The one time age relaxation shall be maximum of 10 years over and above the upper age limit as prescribed in the Recruitment Rules in order to enable them to participate in the first regular recruitment process for the post for which they fulfill all other conditions mentioned in the RRs proposed by the Oversight Committee.

<u>BoG-XXXI(2022)-6</u>: Grant of Financial upgradation under Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) for Non-Teaching employees of NIT Meghalaya.

It was informed to the Board that Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Gol, vide O.M. No. 5034/3/2015-Estt.(D) dated 22.10.2019 has considered and recommended for continuation of MACPS based on the recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission as before. The MACPS shall continue to be administered at 10, 20 and 30 years. Under the Scheme, the employee will move to immediate next Pay Level in the new Pay Matrix.

The Board was further apprised that there are three non-teaching employees who joined NIT Meghalaya in 2012 and shall be completing ten years of continuous service in the same designation and the same Pay Level, as per details shown in the table below, and will be eligible for financial upgradation under MACPS as per the above mentioned O.M. dated 22.10.2019:

The Board deliberated in details on MACPS with reference to the above said O.Ms, wherein it is mentioned that "it would be appropriate to delegate the power for the approving of such proposals to the administrative Ministries/ Departments concerned and that the Department of Expenditure has accordingly approved for extending the benefits of the MACPS to the Central Autonomous/ Statutory Bodies under various Ministries/ Departments subject to them satisfying the four conditions mentioned therein.

It was explained to the Board members that the first conditions shall not be applicable to NIT Meghalaya since NIT Meghalaya started operations only in 2012. The second condition was to obtain the approval of the BoG and the third condition was to obtain the concurrence of Ministry and

the fourth condition was the financial implications for extending the benefits of MACPS to the employees of NIT Meghalaya. During discussion all the August members including representatives of the Ministry of Education agreed for adoption and implementation of MACPS applicable to the employees of the Institute as and when they become eligible including the three employees mentioned above. The expenditure on their pay upgradation is meager and can easily be met out of the existing Budget.

The Board considered and approved for adoption and implementation of MACPS applicable to all the non teaching eligible employees for their financial upgradation in future including the three employees mentioned above.

<u>BoG-XXXI(2022)-R6:</u> The Board RESOLVED to APPORVE for ADOPTION and IMPLEMENTATION of MACPS applicable to the three employees as mentioned above. The Board also AGREED and APPROVED for ADOPTION and IMPLEMENTATION of MACPS mutatis mutandis applicable to all other non teaching eligible employees for their financial upgradation in future.

<u>BoG-XXXI (2022)-7</u>: Signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India and National Institute of Technology Meghalaya, Shillong for the FY 2022-23 in pursuance of the Rule 229 (xi) of the GFR, 2017.

It was informed to the Board member that each year Ministry of Education sends the draft Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for entering into a MoU between Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, GoI and National Institute of Technology Meghalaya, Shillong for the particular Financial Year in pursuance of Rule 229 (xi) of the GFR, 2017.

The Board was apprised of the difficulty in preparing, filling up the required data and sending the signed copy of the MoU duly approved by the Board immediately on receipt of the draft MoU to the Ministry in a very short time.

Therefore, after deliberation the Board accepted the proposal and authorised the Director, NIT Meghalaya to sign and send the MoU along with all the relevant documents/infoṛmation to the Ministry of Education after obtaining the approval of the Chairman, BoG upon receiving the draft MoU from the Ministry of Education for the Financial Year 2022-23 to save the time.

<u>BoG-XXX(2022)-R7</u>: The Board AUTHORISED the Director, NIT Meghalaya to sign and send the MoU along with all the relevant documents/information to the Ministry of Education in pursuance of Rule 229 (xi) of the GFR, 2017, after getting the approval of the Chairman, BoG upon receiving the draft MoU from the Ministry of Education for the Financial Year 2022-23 and thereafter in each years to save the time.

<u>BoG-XXXI(2022)-8:</u> Standing Agenda Item: Mechanism to Monitor/ minimize Audit Objections Public Grievances and Parliamentary Assurances.

It was informed to the Board members that the Ministry of Education has instructed to include complete details and status of their Audit Paras, Pending Public Grievances and Parliamentary Assurances in every meeting of Finance Committee (FC)/ Board of Governors (BoG) as **Standing Agenda Item**.

Accordingly, the following information was placed before the Board for information and guidance.

- (a) The minor observations of Audit stated in the Separate Audit Report (SAR) have been replied.
 - It was also informed to the Board that the responsibility for preparing the Annual Accounts for the year 2021-22 has been entrusted to a Shillong based Chartered Accountant firm M/S SSD & Co. The work is in progress and on completion the report of the Annual Accounts of the Institute for the year 2021-22, and shall be placed before the Board in the forthcoming meeting.
- (a) It was informed to the Board members that there is no Pending Public Grievances in respect of NIT Meghalaya on the Public Grievance Portal of Government of India as on date.
- (b) It was informed to the Board members that there is no pending case related to Parliamentary Assurances and replies to parliament questions in respect of NIT Meghalaya were always sent on time.

BoG-XXXI(2022)-R8: The Board NOTED the ACTION TAKEN by the Institute.

BoG-XXXI (2022)-9: Special drive to fill the backlog vacancies on Mission Mode.

The board was informed that the backlog vacancies for the faculty positions lying vacant, especially in the SC/ST/OBC and EWS category of the Institute shall be filled up in a Mission Mode by 4th September, 2022. In this connection, the Institute was instructed to send the report about the action taken and progress made in this regard through the following 03 (three) mechanism. The 07 backlog vacancies are in reserved category i.e., 05 OBC and 02 SC. The Institute is in the process of filling up the backlog vacancies and fresh vacancies shortly. Scrutiny of the applications is over. The approved lists of Visitor's nomination have been received and appropriate actions are being initiated to complete the faculty recruitment process on time. The Director of the Institute explained that the délay in obtaining the Visitor's nominee list delayed the recruitment and selection of Faculty members. He further informed the Board members including the MoE nominees about the present situation and his completion of the tenure on 30th June 2022 including the request Letter dated 11.05.2022 sent to the Ministry for considering and Authorising the Director of the Institute to complete the Selection process during his tenure. The Ministry Officials stated that the matter is under process and the decision of the Ministry would be conveyed accordingly. The Institute is regularly sending the monthly The Heads of all CHEIs to send a monthly 3. report to Secretary (HE) (starting from report to the Office of Higher Education (HE), Ministry of Education, appraising the September 2021) appraising the status of action taken. status of action taken in filling up the backlog vacancies. The report for the month of April 2022 was sent on 11.05.2022 vide Letter No. NITMGH/ ES/ MoEd-RPT/BV/2022-23/214 dated 11/05/2022.
