

## **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ATTEND CONFERENCES, etc.**

### **A.Science and Engineering Research Board (DST)**

International Travel Support (ITS) ITS scheme is designed to provide financial assistance for presenting a research paper or chairing a session or delivering a keynote address in an international scientific event (conference/seminar/symposium/workshop etc.). In addition, support is also provided to young scientists (age limit 35 years as on date of conference) for attending training programmes and short-term schools/workshops/courses. Economy class air-fare by shortest route, airport-tax and visa fees are provided under the scheme. Registration Fee is provided to young scientist in addition to the above support.

### **B. Centre for International Co-operation in Science (CICS) INSA-CSIR-DAE / BRNS-CICS Travel Fellowship**

CICS (formerly CCSTDS) provides partial travel fellowship / registration to scientists/researchers in various disciplines such as Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Medicine, Engineering, Space Science & Technology, Computer Science and Engineering, etc. to attend international conferences, seminars and workshops abroad.

These Microsoft Research India grants may also be awarded to students who already receive financial assistance, but need additional funds to travel to a conference outside India. The grants are open to students who are enrolled at an Indian university. Applicants should be students who are working towards their bachelor's, master's, or PhD degree. Eligible students must be enrolled in computer science, electrical engineering, electrical/electronics communication engineering, mathematics, or a field that closely relates to computer science.
