Memorandum of Understanding between National Institute of Technology Meghalaya and Indian Institute of Technology Mandi

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between:

National Institute of Technology Meghalaya (NIT Meghalaya) Saitsohpen Sohra, East Khasi Hills, Meghalaya, India- 793108 represented by its **Director** of the one part which expression shall include its successors in position, executors and administrators/including statutory authorized professionals;

And

Indian Institute of Technology Mandi (IIT Mandi), Mandi 175075, Himachal Pradesh of the other part which expression shall include his successors in position, executors and administrators/including statutory authorized professionals.

The **NIT, Meghalaya** and **IIT Mandi** are here in after individually referred to as “**Party**” and collectively referred to as the “**Parties**”.

Objectives of the Memorandum of Understanding

Both NIT Meghalaya and IIT Mandi are government funded institutions and are established by the Government of India through an act of Parliament to promote and support academics and research for the development of academic and technological excellence in both the institutions. Accordingly, both the signatory parties after protracted discussion have agreed to cooperate in the following main activities:

- Exchange visits of faculty and staff for the purpose of research, teaching and consultancy with prior approval from both the institutions for a duration of up to one year.
- Joint supervision of postgraduate and Ph.D. students as per the norms of both the institutions.
- Permissible exchange of scientific information for academic purposes.
- Utilization of research facilities at special usage charges applicable for H.P. users.
- Training of students on facilities at both the institutes subject to availability of resources without jeopardizing the main activities of the signatory parties.
- Joint research activities through participation in nationally and internationally funded projects including the sponsored projects of the either Institution.
- Organization of joint events such as seminars, workshops, conferences, training programs, etc.
- Exchange of students for 1 or 2 semesters for course work and projects with the possibility of transfer of credits as per the norms of the signatory institutions.
- Any other objective as agreed upon in writing between both the institutions.

1. Financial Arrangements:

Both the parties acknowledge and understand that all financial arrangements, if any, will be subjected to prior written agreement and availability of funds for each activity undertaken.

2. Duration renewal:

The MoU is signed initially for five years at the first instance from the date of signing of this MoU. Further continuance of this MoU will be subject to joint agreement and upon review by both parties to be undertaken before the expiry of this MoU.

3. Advertising and Publicity:

Both the institute may advertise this MoU for information of students, faculty, staff and the general public considering the positive externalities of this MoU intending for societal development.

4. Modification of MoU:

This MoU may be modified at any time if circumstances arise which call for any alteration, subject to the consent and approval of both parties.

5. Statutory Compliance:

This MoU solely expresses the intention of both institutions to promote education and Technology under the neo-governmental policy of Government of India. It is agreed that it does not have a legal effect nor create any financial obligations on either institution functioning under a common nodal Government Department.

6. Confidentiality:

Both institutions agree and undertake to keep confidential any information/ data exchanged, acquired, or shared in connection with any program or activity conducted under this MoU.

7. Governance:

All terms of this MoU are subject to the laws of the Republic of India and acts, statutes and ordinances of both the institutions.

8. Signature on MoU:

Both the institutions in good faith agree to execute the objectives of the MoU within the framework of terms of reference of this agreement.

This MoU is written in two identical originals, both of equal validity, a copy each to be retained by the signatory parties.






