Item No.3: List of Medal Recipients to be Awarded during the 12th Convocation.

The Dean (Students' Welfare) elaborated the detailed process followed for the selection of the **President Gold Medal** and **Chairperson Gold Medal**. The Dean (Academic Affairs) explained the procedure adopted for the **Institute Gold Medals** and **Institute Silver Medals**, including the evaluation parameters and committee recommendations as per ordinance.

The Senate reviewed the recommendations and approved the list of medal recipients for the 12th Convocation – 2025. However, the Senate suggested that the process and criteria for selection of medals may be revisited, as in certain cases the same student was found to be receiving both the Institute Gold Medal and Institute Silver Medal. The Senate recommended that suitable modifications in the criteria be proposed for future convocations to avoid such overlaps.

Item No.4: List of Awardees for Best Thesis and Best Project.

The Dean (Academic Affairs) elaborated the detailed process followed for the selection of the **Best Thesis (M.Tech)** and **Best Project (M.Sc.) Awards**. The process involved evaluation of nominations received from departments, review by the respective Departmental Committees, and final recommendations by the Institute-level Selection Committee duly approved by the Competent Authority.

The Senate reviewed the recommendations and approved the list of awardees as presented in Annexure–4.1.

During the deliberation, the Senate suggested that nominations could also be invited directly from the students. This would help ensure wider participation and recognition of meritorious work from across all eligible candidates. The Senate advised to **consider this suggestion**.
